BIOGRAPHY OF GIUSEPPE SCIACCA AND GOALS OF THE AWARD

Giuseppe Sciacca (Rome 12.08.1960 - 21.09.1986 †) was a student of architecture who, during his short life, proved to be a role model of strong moral integrity and of great generosity towards his fellow human beings. An tragic accident (parachute failure, during the festival in honour of Our Blessed Lady of the Divine Love) cut his life short in the sky above the venerated Roman Sanctuary. The International Culture and Voluntary Work Association "Uomo e Società" and the International "Giuseppe Sciacca" Award chose him – who was a committed exponent of eternal values – as an example for the new generations, in a day and age that is sadly marked by a strong crisis of identity among youths. Firmly believing that the root and foundation of human dignity are what can lead us back to our Lord and Creator, the Sciacca Award wants to become the voice of every human being whose divine dignity is blatantly disregarded and deliberately violated. Without God there cannot be any justice: each individual achieves due respect only when society commits to abide by and implement the principles of natural law, as a realistic expression of the Eternal Law. Otherwise the door is left open to abuse and oppression. This is what the International "Giuseppe Sciacca" Award aspires to and the message it wants to impart through its successful work.





Among the various charitable activities carried out by the Award, we can single out the strong bond that has been established with Poland via the "Giuseppe Sciacca" Fund for Orthopaedic Braces, in cooperation with the City of Kielce and thanks to the kind generosity of the Emilian Orthopaedic Centre. Currently, the "Giuseppe Sciacca" Fund for Orthopaedic Braces is the only institution operating in the nation which donates free orthopaedic instruments to all those children suffering from *spina bifida*, an endemic disease that affects approximately 500 children every year. Braces can radically change the lives of many children, as they are indispensable for their walking.

Every year the Jury of the International "Giuseppe Sciacca" Award assigns an Overall Award to a person who has exhibited high moral standards, vital for the evolution of society, or has served as a sound role model of ability and efficiency in the general interest.

Furthermore, the Jury confers special recognitions to people who have distinguished themselves in various fields of knowledge and art pursuant to the following two categories:

Young Scholars - (up to 35 years of age), divided into eleven sub-sections:

- Communication, Journalism, Cinema and Theatre
- Sports and Art
- Drawing, Graphic Design, Photography and Music
- Culture of Peace, Protection of the Minors
- Fiction, Non-fiction and Poetry
- Legal and Historical sciences
- Economy, Research and Development
- Young Entrepreneurs
- Social and Voluntary activities

<u>Special Awards -</u> important personalities from the cultural or institutional field, divided into two sub-sections (Special Awards):

- Culture Award
- Jury Special Awards

The Jury will come to a final decision regarding the "Young scholars" category once they have screened the examination papers, which should be submitted no later than the 2^{nd} of October 2013.

Participation in the competition is reserved exclusively for the **Young Scholars'** Category. Therefore, any **Special Awards** will be conferred by the Jury whose decision is unquestionable.

"Young Scholars" Category - 9 Sections

I – COMMUNICATION, JOURNALISM, CINEMA, AND THEATRE

Communication

"St. Bernardine of Siena"

"St. Bernardine of Siena (Massa Marittima 1380 – L'Aquila 1444) is one of the greatest preachers in the history of the Church. Distinguished theologian, fierce advocate for the helpless, he spread devotion in the name of Jesus Christ by conceiving the monogram "IHS" and by fighting passionately against the social plague of usury. St. Bernardino is the patron of the Italian advertisers."

Candidates must submit two signed copies of an article, monograph, essay or any other material of their choice concerning the topic of this section, as well as two signed copies of their curriculum vitae. Graduate or postgraduate thesis on dvd/cd-rom, prepared during the last five years, are also accepted in two signed copies.

<u>Journalism</u>

Candidates must send a collection of three articles in two signed copies (along with two signed copies of their curriculum vitae), published on a national or international newspaper or magazine in the last three years. Graduate or postgraduate thesis on dvd/cd-rom, prepared during the last five years, are also accepted in two signed copies.

Cinema and Theatre

Candidates must submit two copies of an article, monograph, essay or any other material concerning cinema and theatre of their choice, as well as two signed copies of the artist/director's curriculum vitae. Films can be submitted in dvd/cd-rom format and must be: a) Short films (no longer than 15 minutes); b) Feature films (no longer than 30 minutes); c) Documentaries (no longer than 30 minutes); d) Performances; e) Music videos. Any work in a language different from Italian should be subtitled or dubbed in Italian.

II – SPORT AND ARTS

<u>Sports</u>

Candidates must submit two signed copies of an article, monograph, essay or any other material of their choice concerning sports with particular reference to Olympic disciplines, as well as two signed copies of their curriculum vitae. Films in dvd/cd-rom format with a duration of up to 20 minutes can also be submitted. All the youths who want to participate in this section should refer back to the Protocol of Agreement signed with **CONI - Italian National Olympic Committee.**

Arts

Candidates must submit two signed copies of an article, monograph, essay, sculpture or any other material of their choice regarding the artistic sector, as well as two signed copies of their curriculum vitae. They are also invited to submit films in dvd/cd-rom format with a duration of up to 20 minutes. All youths who want to participate in this section should refer back to the Protocol of Agreement signed with **F.I.T.P. – Italian Federation for Popular Traditions**.

III – DRAWING, GRAPHIC DESIGN, POTOGRAPHY AND MUSIC

Drawing, Graphic Design and Photography

Candidates are invited to submit two signed copies of an article, monograph, essay or any other material of their choice on the History of Art the length of which should not exceed 150 pages. They must submit up to 5 original drawing or graphic works on any subject the dimensions of which cannot exceed 24 cm x 36 cm. The same applies for black and white or colored photos, which can be submitted bearing a caption, as well **as** the date and place where they have been taken. Candidates must also send two signed copies of their curriculum vitae. The Jury reserves the right to organize an exhibition of the works submitted. Those who will be competing in this section of the Award are invited to create original artwork regarding the image of Giuseppe Sciacca.

Music

Candidates must submit a demo disk in audio or video format, containing one or more (published or unpublished) music tracks or covers, along with their artistic curriculum vitae (all material should be in two copies).

IV - CULTURE OF PEACE AND PROTECTION OF MINORS

"Francisco and Jacinta of Fatima"

" In 1917 two children, Francisco and Jacinta Marto (7 and 8 years old), along with their little cousin Lucy, were the witnesses of the famed apparitions at Fatima. Candidates must submit two signed copies of an article, monograph, essay or any other material of their choice, as well as two signed copies of their curriculum vitae. Graduate or postgraduate thesis on dvd/cd-rom prepared during the last five years can also be sent, along with their curriculum vitae (all material should be in two copies). All young participants indicated by the **Juvenile Justice Department of the Ministry of the Justice** should refer back to the Protocol of Agreement and related Regulation between the Association "Uomo e Società" and the above mentioned Department. Those minors who will be competing in this section of the Award are invited to create original artwork regarding the image of Giuseppe Sciacca.

V-FICTION, NON-FICTION AND POETRY

Fiction

Candidates must always submit in two signed copies a selection of up to four published or unpublished tales, granted that they have been written from 1996 onwards, as well as two signed copies of their curriculum vitae. Tales published on national or international magazines are also accepted.

Non-fiction

Candidates must always submit two signed copies of a selection of up to four published or unpublished essays of any length, granted that they have been written from 1996 onwards, as well as two signed copies of their curriculum vitae. Essays published on national or international magazines are also accepted.

Economy

Candidates must submit two signed copies of an article, monograph, essay or any other material of their choice, as well as two signed copies of their curriculum vitae. Graduate or postgraduate thesis on dvd/cd-rom, prepared during the last five years can also be sent, along with their curriculum vitae (all material should be in two copies).

Research and Development

Candidates must submit two signed copies of an article, graduate or postgraduate thesis or any other material of their choice concerning specialized subjects on research and development, in various areas of interest, national or international in scope, as well as two signed copies of their curriculum vitae. Graduate or postgraduate thesis on dvd/cd-rom, prepared during the last five years, can also be sent, along with their curriculum vitae (all material should be in two copies).

Graduate or postgraduate thesis on dvd/cd-rom, prepared during the last five years, can also be sent, along with their curriculum vitae (all material should be in two copies).

GENERAL TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

Participation is open to citizens of Italy or any other country who are under 35 years of age and who will submit their application form and works (in Italian if written) to the President of the Awards' Office (Via dei Baglioni, 19 - 00164Roma) no later than the 2nd of October 2013. Applicants should fill in and send the application form (Attached A) with all necessary data (otherwise, they will be excluded from the competition). Those who wish to participate in the Young Scholars' category are required to pay a symbolic fee of 10,00 Euros (via a non-negotiable cheque or a postal order to the attention of "Premio Internazionale "Giuseppe Sciacca" or a deposit to the post office account 1005604655 to the attention of "Premio Internazionale "Giuseppe Sciacca") to cover part of the expenses of the President's Office. Participation is free only for junior high or senior high school students, as well as University students, who will attach a certificate of attendance, or an equivalent declaration (according to the D.P.R. 445/2000). The application form and the examination papers (texts, documents, dvd, cd-rom, etc.) should be dispatched no later than the 2nd of October 2013 (date as per postmark) to the President's Office of the Sciacca Award otherwise, candidates will be excluded from the competition. All works realized for the purpose of the Award can draw inspiration from the personality of Giuseppe Sciacca and his exemplary life, or reproduce the symbol of the Award itself (the Caravel). The biography of Giuseppe Sciacca, as well as the images and symbol of the award are available on the official website: www.premiosciacca.it. In the section "Culture of Peace and Protection of Minors Francisco and Jacinta of Fatima", one or more scholarships are offered to pupils indicated by the Ministry of Justice's Department of Juvenile Justice. For the terms of participation for those youths kindly refer back to the Protocol of Agreement between the Association "Uomo e Società" and the above mentioned Department. Candidates are strongly recommended to send their works as soon as possible in order to facilitate the Jury in the evaluation process. The winner of the first place in each section will receive a diploma of merit, trophy or a plate and a medal. Should the Jury deem it appropriate, they may select second and third place runners up in each section who will receive a parchment and a medal after the ceremony, or later - by appointment - at the President's Office. The Jury could also confer diplomas and medals to other finalist participants and works, and indicate any other interesting work. The Jury may also draw attention to other noteworthy feature works or editors. Winners will be informed by the President's Office via either mail, fax, e-mail or hone. The Awards ceremony will take place on November 16th, 2013, at The Great Hall of the Pontifical Urbaniana University – Via Urbano VIII, 16 – Rome – Vatican City, before the Jury, as well as civil, military and religious authorities. Strong press and TV media presence is anticipated. The Presidency of the Award will announce, at their earliest convenience, the location and precise date, which are in the process of being decided. Both in the Young Scholars and the Special Awards category, the prizes must be received by the winners themselves. The President's Office will not send any award by post.
